Surprise your cat with these purr-fectly spooktacular snacks and toys for Halloween!

KITTY COOKIES

What You Need

- 🍷 5-oz can of tuna in water (undrained)
- 🍷 1 egg
- 🍷 ¾ cup flour
- 🍷 ¼ cup cornmeal

TIP: If your cat doesn't like the taste of tuna, you can use chicken instead.

What You Do

- 1 Preheat oven to 350°.
- 2 Combine all the ingredients in a large mixing bowl.
- 3 Knead the dough into a ball. Then spread it out with a rolling pin until the dough is about ¼ inch thick. (If it's too sticky, you can add more flour.)
- 4 Use small cookie cutters to create fun bite-sized shapes. Bake on a greased cookie sheet or one lined with parchment paper for about 20 minutes. (Ask an adult for help.) Let treats cool completely before serving to your cat.
- 5 Store these treats in the refrigerator for up to a week to keep them from spoiling. 🐾
