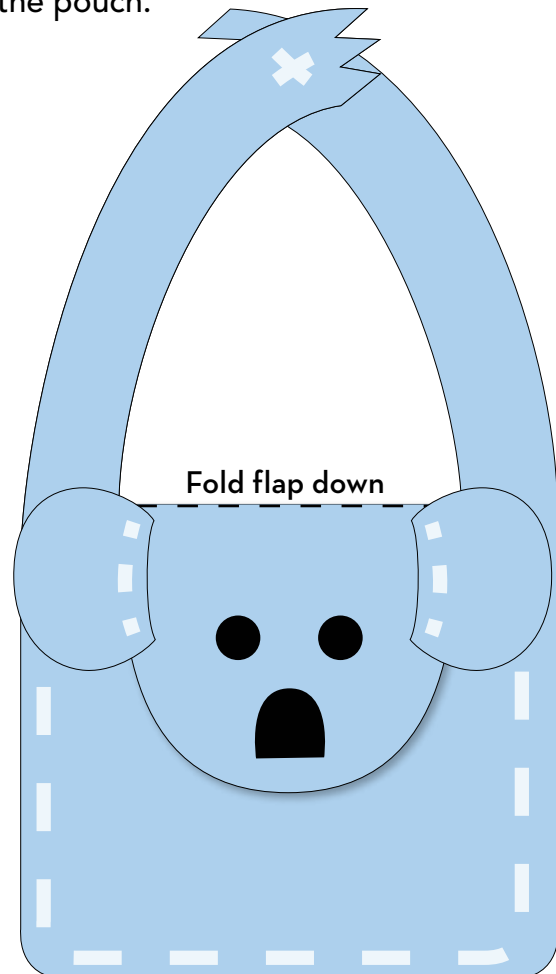
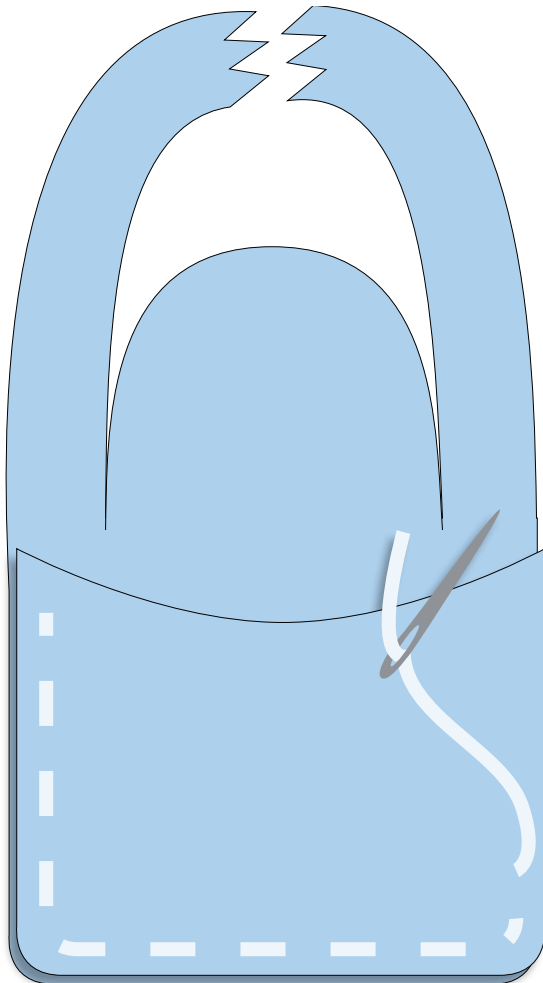


What You Need:

- 2 sheets of felt (Pick the color based on the animal you want to make.)
- yard of yarn (Pick a color to match the felt.)
- 2 googly eyes or 2 small black pom-poms
- small strip of Velcro®
- scissors, fabric glue, darning needle

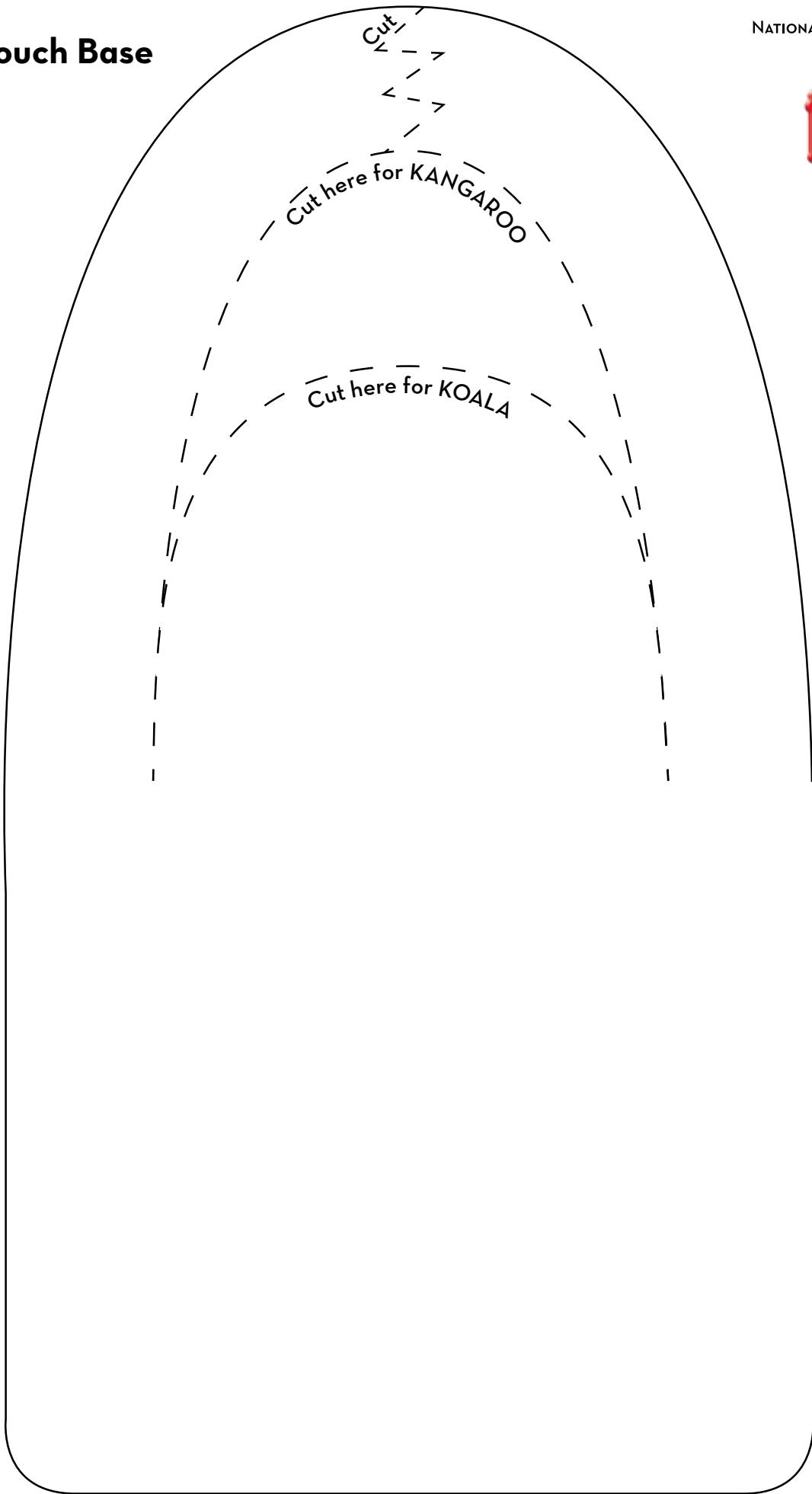
What You Do:

1. Use the patterns on the following pages to cut the pieces out of the felt.
2. Lay the front of the pouch front on top of the pouch base. Stitch together with yarn.
3. Stitch the ears to the head. Then stitch the two arms together to make a handle.
4. Glue the nose and eyes onto the animal's face.
5. Lift the flap and attach the Velcro® to close the pouch.



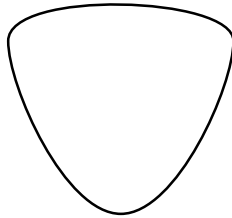
Pouch Base

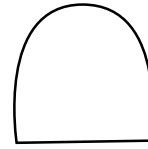




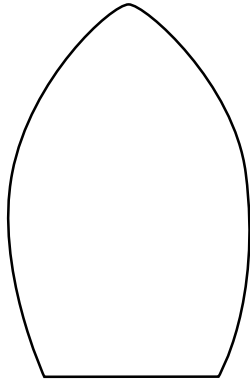
Pouch Details



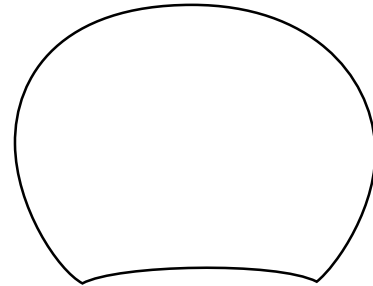
Kangaroo Nose
