Climbing Bear Cub

Instructions:

- 1. Color the bear and the tree.
- 2. Glue this pattern sheet onto a piece of cardboard. Set aside to dry.
- 3. Cut out the tree and the bear from the cardboard. Staple the bear onto a 9"x ³/₄" piece of cardboard.
- Cut a slit in the bottom of the tree trunk (shown here).
- 5. Slide the bear's handle through the slit. Then use the handle to move the bear up and down the tree as directed by the poem.
