

Tiger Puppet

What you need

- 2 sheets orange felt
- sheet of black felt
- sheet of white felt
- black pipe cleaner
- 72" black shoelace
- 6" plastic twine
- 2 googly eyes
- hole punch and scissors
- glue
- black marker



What you do

1. Use the pattern to cut two tiger shapes out of the orange felt. Cut the eyes, nose, and teeth out of the black and white felt.
2. Place the two tiger shapes on top of each other and punch holes as shown on the pattern.
3. Lace the shoelace through the holes to make the tiger's body. Tie a knot at the first and last hole.
4. Bend the pipe cleaner as shown on the pattern. Glue onto the front of the puppet to make the tiger's mouth.
5. Glue the pieces of twine above the mouth. Unravel both ends to make the tiger's whiskers.
6. Glue on the eyes, nose, and teeth as shown in the photo.
7. Use the black marker to draw on the tiger's stripes. (See photo).

Tiger Pattern

Eyes—black (cut 2)

Nose—
black (cut 1)

Mouth—make from
pipecleaner

Teeth—white (cut 4)
