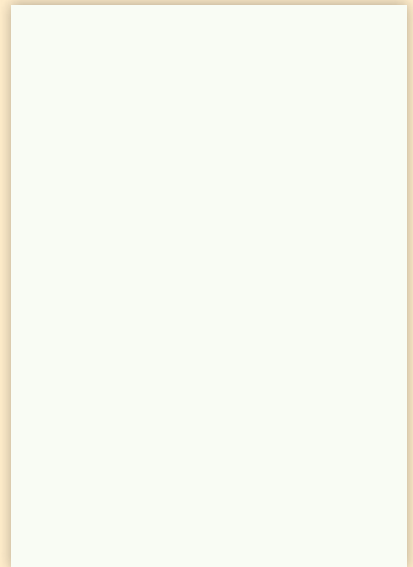
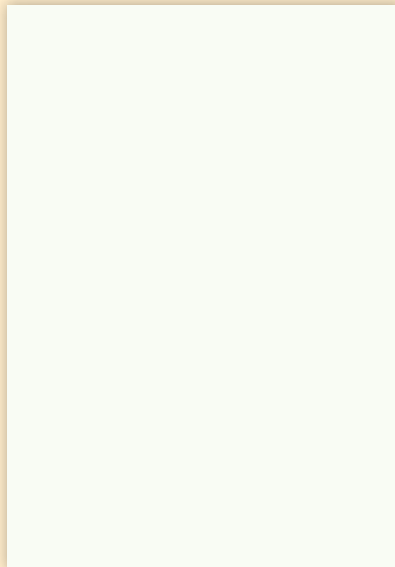
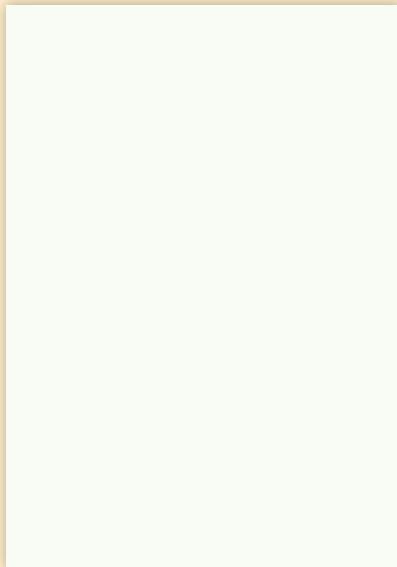
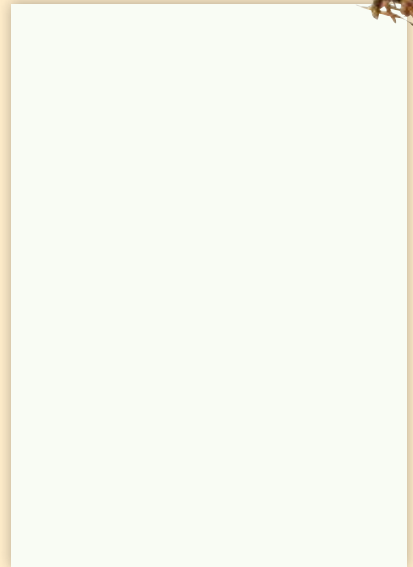
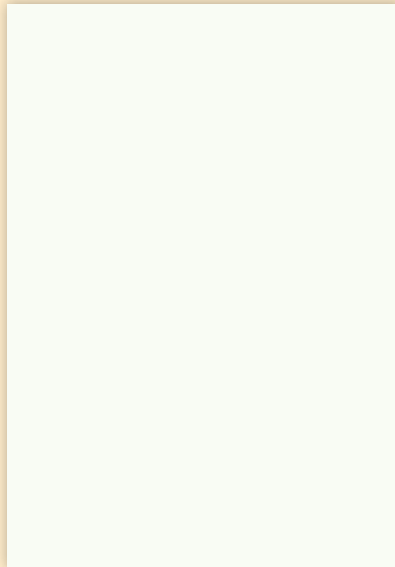
- Magnifying glass
